

FGC post graduate certificate in FGC coordination

Bursary Guidance

- I. Family Rights Group is operating a bursary scheme for applications to the 'post graduate certificate in FGC coordination'. Applications can be made to cover the costs associated with undertaking the award up to an amount of £450. This can cover:
 - i. Cost of associate tutor
 - ii. Administration costs to FRG
 - iii. University registration costs
 - iv. Associate tutor advanced training costs

FRG reserves the right to make part payment of these costs depending on available funds and the individual circumstances of applicants.

2. In order to qualify, you will need to meet at least one of the following requirements:
 - i. You are an FGC co-ordinator working with marginalised communities,
 - ii. You are an FGC co-ordinator employed by a small project that are unable to cover the costs of accreditation
 - iii. You are a self employed FGC co-ordinator
 - iv. You are an associate tutor who is unable to finance their attendance at required training (this may be due to withdrawal of employer funding)
