

FAMILY SUPPORT AND COMMUNITY CARE ADVICE FOR ASYLUM SEEKING FAMILIES

The charity Family Rights Group has launched a new project, which aims to support children to be raised safely within their families, regardless of the immigration status of themselves and their family.

Family Rights Group's Advice and Advocacy Service can provide free advice and information:

- ü on childcare law, procedures and policy;
- ü on child protection practice and procedures;
- ü on local authority family and community care support for families who are seeking asylum;
- ü on local authority family and community care support for families who have been refused asylum;

The service will also, where appropriate, assist a family to challenge a local authority decision to refuse support.

We can provide advice and information to organisations advising asylum seekers whose children are involved with local authority children's services or who want local authority support to help them raise their child:
