You do not need to work in the social care profession to become a FGC Coordinator, you just need to have the passion for enabling and empowering people who may sometimes have difficulties resolving or addressing concerns or worries within their family network. Alternatively, you may already work in "people services" and want to introduce the model in your team or organisation or develop your professional skills or become an Independent FGC Coordinator.
